I am aware that many churches frown on Halloween as a sort of devilish holiday that encourages children to believe in ghosts and magic and the like. While I would not challenge anyone's personal faith on this issue, it might be helpful for you to know that All Hallow's Eve was once a holy day in the church's calendar. November 1 is All Saints Day when we commemorate all the saints who have served Christ in large and small ways. All Hallow's Eve, the day before All Saints Day, was a time to prepare for the feast.

Because All Saints Day commemorates the blessed dead, All Hallow's Eve became a time when many believed that the veil between the physical world and the spiritual world became thin. Jack-o-lanterns and lights were displayed to scare off these possibly malignant spirits. In more recent years, these decorations, along with costumes and scary stories, are no longer viewed as a way to scare away malignant ghosts, but rather as a way to have fun.

Halloween, or All Hallow's Eve, in its present incarnation, presents no spiritual danger to us. If we approach it with a healthy attitude—that it is simply another way to have fun with our kids—then it surely poses no genuine spiritual threat. So dress your kids as devils and angels, princesses and pirates, ghosts and ghouls. Hang up those skeletons and witches and decorate to your heart's content. God will smile and enjoy it all alongside you.
